Workshop on Vedic Math

Students... Take Charge!

Well, it's back to school in just a few weeks. Are you ready? Whether you are a teacher or a student you are probably having mixed feelings. Summer is never long enough and yet at the same time, it's too long.

So, how are you going to start the school year? Hopefully, with a great excitement! Both teachers and students hold responsibilities here. So often, students want to put the responsibility on the teacher and vice versa.

There are many articles written to help the teachers make the class enthusiastic. This article focuses on looking at the situation from the student's perspective. The atmosphere of the classroom depends on the student's attitude as much as of the teacher.

I saw a poster one time that really said it all. It listed the items each student needed to bring to class..... writing utensils, books and paper. But it added one more item that students often don't think about. It advised the students to come into class with "an open mind".

Now, I am not suggesting that students should accept everything the teacher says, or even the text book. But I am suggesting students should be open to consider everything that is taught. There is as much danger in just accepting what is taught as it is i.e. accepting anything.

Here's a suggestion. Try really listening to what is being said in your classroom. Look at what the text book says. Listen to what the teacher presents and offer arguments if you disagree. Again, I am not suggesting disrespect. There is a way to present arguments without being disrespectful. You will be surprised at what will happen to the atmosphere in the classroom when you become involved.

There are several respectful ways to address your disagreement:

- **Be informal:** know why you disagree. Don't argue for the sake of argument, this just makes you look bad.
- **Raise your hand:** Even though you may feel very forceful or emotional about your argument, don't just blurt out. This may result in a discipline action. Get your teacher's attention before making your statement.
- **Be Prepared:** this requires homework. The best possible way to do that is to read the chapter ahead

of time. Know what the text says before you walk into class.

- Have references to back up your arguments. Be able to quote or know where to go to get information to back up your arguments.
- **Be quiet:** After you present argument, be quiet. Allow your teacher to answer. You may be surprised to find out he/she actually agrees with you and not the text book. He/she may be able to help your next presentation.

On the flip side, may be you don't have a disagreement with the text. If you have pre-read the chapter, you may be able to give input into the teacher's lecture. The text may bring out points that you actually agree with or may be the subject one is one you find interesting. Don't be afraid to comment on the positive side in class. As a reminder do it respectfully.

Class is much more enjoyable when you participate. Becoming actively involved in your education is the best way to keep a good attitude. Most teachers do not want a boring class. Most often, a teacher finds it necessary to stop a discussion when it is out of hand.

Here are few tips to keep the teacher on your side:

Raise your hand, don't blurt out, regardless of whether your point is for or against what is being said. Make a point. Have a valid reason for your argument. Keep it short. Don't take too much time to make your point. Be quiet. Once you have made your point, STOP. Allow someone else the opportunity to speak.

Surprisingly enough, if you look at the points on conversation, you will see the same points again. No matter what the subject keep these points in mind. These will keep you out of trouble, class interesting, and life relatively simple.

Here's to a great school year! Get actively involved. Show the world what you're made of and enjoy life. Remember, you only get one chance at life. Take it!

Guided Souls



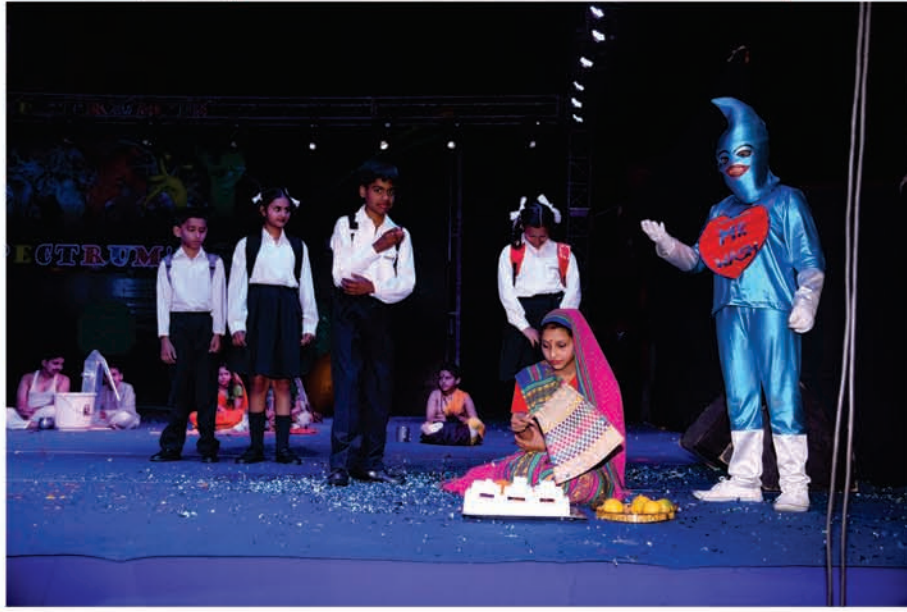

(APJ Abdul Kalam)

APJ Abdul Kalam was a renowned Indian scientist, who went to become the eleventh president of India (2002-2007). APJ Abdul Kalam was well known across India and was a recipient of India's three most coveted civilian awards:

Padam Vibhushan

Bharat Ratna

"Wings Of Fire" is an autobiography of APJ Abdul Kalam covering his early life and his work in Indian Space Research And Missile Programs. It is a story of a boy from a humble background who went on to become a key player in Indian Space Research and Missile Programs and later became the President of India. The book has been very popular in India and has been translated into multiple languages. I recently picked it up and read it in a couple of days. It was very engaging initially. I loved the initial chapters of it since it gives a vivid picture of our country during 1930-1950s.

Kalam was born in Rameshwaram, a southern religious town in Tamil Nadu. The initial chapters provide an interesting glimpse of religious harmony which existed before India's partition.

A paragraph in the book says- "**The famous Shiva temple, which made Rameshwaram so sacred to pilgrims, was about a ten minutes walk from our house. Our locality was predominantly Muslim but there were a few Hindu families too, living amicably with their Muslim neighbours.**"

Kalam in his early years wanted to be an officer in Air Force, however could not clear the interview. He met Swami Sivananda after his failure.

In the book we read how APJ Abdul Kalam started his career in Aeronautical Development Establishment (ADE) and was involved in the design of a hovercraft. Later he moved to Indian Space Research and Missile Programs. In 1963 Kalam went to NASA facility in Maryland (USA) as a part of training program on sounding rocket launching techniques.

The book covers a lot of behind the scene information and technical details about India's satellite and missile program (SLV-3, Prithvi, Agni, Trishul, Akash, Nag). It covers his personal life briefly, which is strange for an autobiography. He was a poet too and a big fan of poems. The book contains many of his self written poems which indeed is very encouraging.

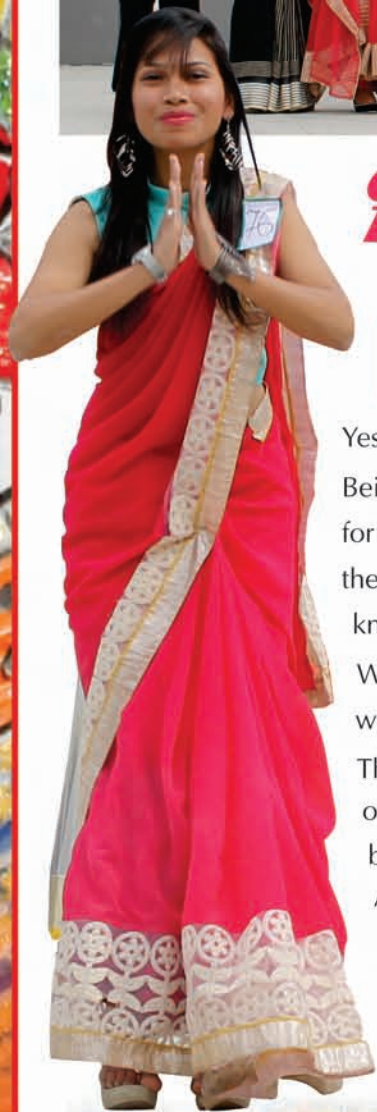

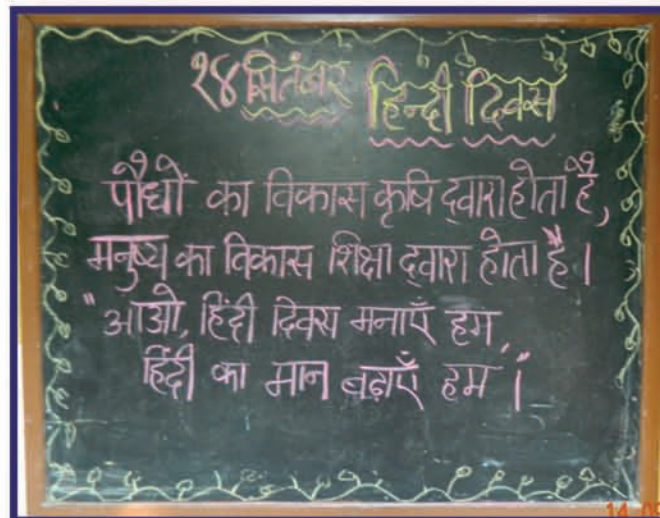


हिन्दी की स्थिति
